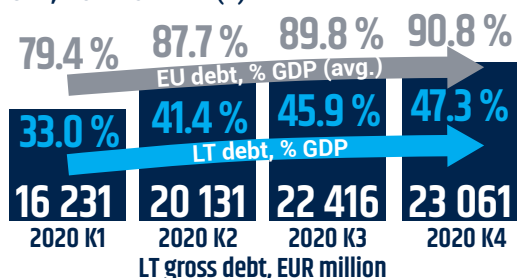
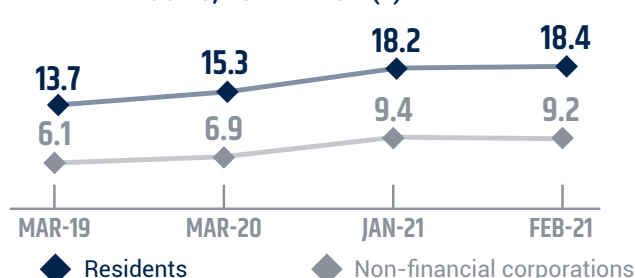

GDP, PUBLIC DEBT (1)

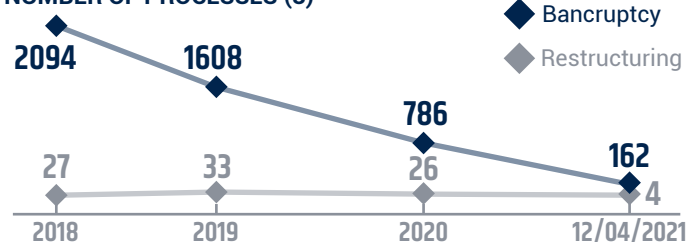


BANK DEPOSITS, EUR BILLION (2)

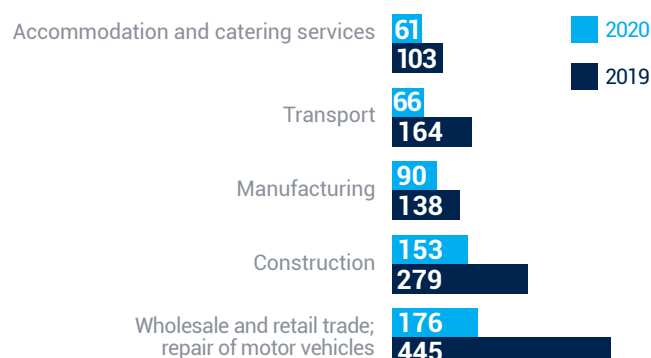

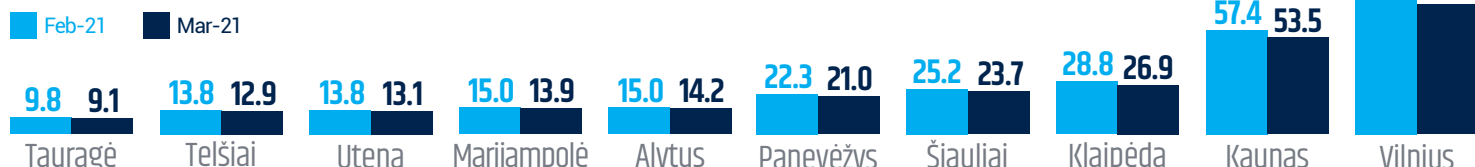
In 2020, the highest number of bankruptcy proceedings was started in the counties of Vilnius (37.8%), Kaunas (26.6%), Klaipėda (14.8%), the lowest number – in the counties of Tauragė (1.9%), Telšiai, and Utena (2% each).

INSOLVENCY PROCEEDINGS BY ECONOMIC ACTIVITY (4)



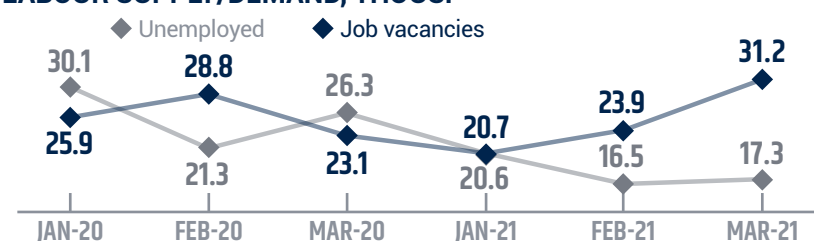
UNEMPLOYMENT (5)

In March 2021, the number of the unemployed fell by 6% (17.2 thous.) to 259.8 thous. per month. In March 2021, the largest decrease in registered unemployment rates (1.5%) was recorded in the municipalities of Pasvalys, Šalčininkai, and Vilkaviškis districts. The largest share of the working-age population was registered as unemployed in the municipalities of Lazdijai (23.4%), Kelmė (20.8%), and Ignalina (20.6%) districts.

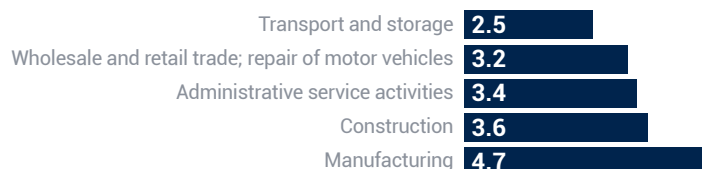


The number of newly registered unemployed persons was 4.9% higher than in February and 34.3% lower than in March last year;

REGISTERED UNEMPLOYED BY THEIR LAST EMPLOYER'S ACTIVITY, 03/2021, THOUS. (TOP5)



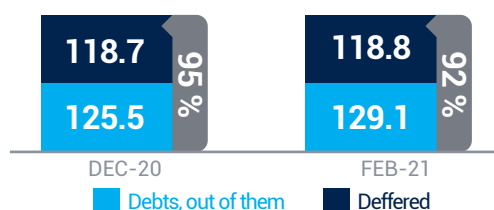

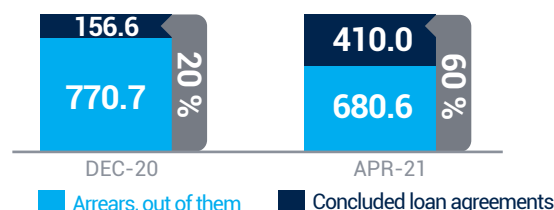

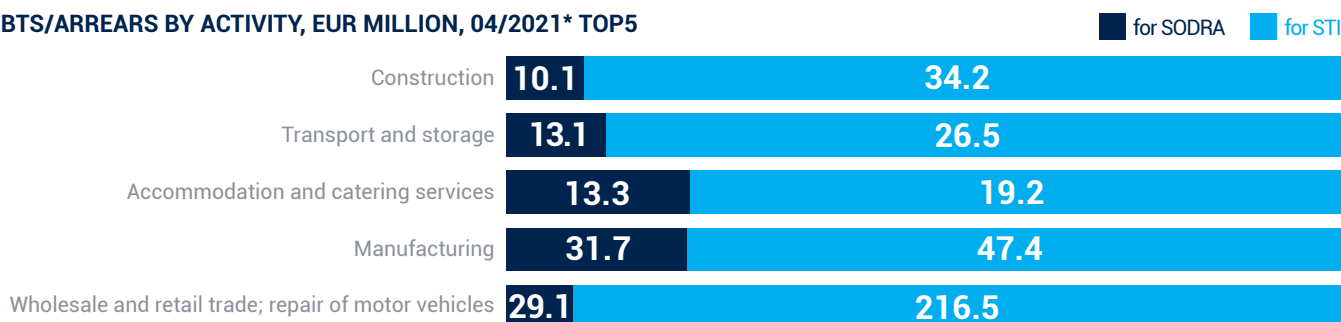
Debts and deferred taxes (SODRA), EUR million*

VMI IDENTIFIED:

- 445 companies paid out EUR 17.9 million in dividends despite having tax arrears of EUR 30.2 million;
- Companies have cumulated EUR 220.3 million in arrears, while in the same period they have around EUR 100 million in bank accounts.
